

What can we learn from the Ancient Greeks?

Week beg:	Home Activities
9 th January	Find out 5 interesting fact about the Ancient Greeks. Include pictures to illustrate.
16 th January	Homework debatell! "Should children have homework?" Write an argument for all the fors and againsts you can think of, even if you have a strong view yourself! Try to make it balanced using some of the linking phrases you have been given! Remember to write a conclusion with your overall viewpoint at the end.
23 rd January	We will be having a Greek day later this term. Research a Greek recipe that we could cook, and that you would like to eat, on that day.
30 th January	Triangles! Make a geometric design on a computer programme such as paint, using only triangles. Colour your design with a range of colours and patterns. Make sure there are a range of triangles and that you can identify them. Make a poster with the design in the centre including the words and facts about the angles in a triangle. Include some information on Pythagoras if you can.
6 th February	Eureka! Write a fact sheet about the Greek scientist Archimedes and his discoveries.
Half Term	
20 th February	Lots of words we use today came from the Ancient Greeks. Research and create a glossary of at least 10 words. Try and learn a word that you didn't know what it meant before.
27 th February	Icarus tried to fly. Describe what you might see if you were to fly around our local area that you might not see from the ground. Draw a bird's eye view of one area you might fly over.
5 th March	Postcard from Athens. Write a postcard as though you are a present day visitor to the ruins of Athens. Describe what you see there and how it makes you feel. Draw a picture of the sights on the front.
12 th March	Prepare an outfit to wear to school for our Greek day next week.
19 th March	Design a pot that tells a story of something about <u>your</u> everyday life in the style of one from Ancient Greece
26 th March	London trip. Collect items to make a diary over the holidays.
Easter Holidays!	Make a London diary as a scrapbook.
